Introduction: The central work of the Holy Spirit involved the apostles.

- A. Jesus personally explained the Holy Spirit's work ahead of time to the apostles.
 - 1. This promise was specific to them. (Jn 15:26-27)
 - 2. But it would be this work through the apostles that would be with us for all time. (Eph 2:20)
- B. As a young man I failed to understand passages that were addressed to inspired men and tried to apply it to myself! (Mt 10:18-20)

I. The Holy Spirit revealed a perfect message through the Apostles

- A. As Jesus was leaving this world He prepared His disciples for the Spirit's great work. (Jn 16:7-13)
 - 1. He will convict the world of sin.
 - 2. He will convict the world of righteousness.
 - 3. He will convict the world of judgment.
 - 4. When men today preach are they seeking the same purposes as did the Holy Spirit?
- B. The apostles and prophets who revealed God's new message did so without error.

(Jn 14:26;Mt 10:18-20)

- 1. This is a must for us to understand. This is an acid test for inspiration.
- 2. Those who follow the guidance of the Holy Spirit are focus upon truth! (Jn 8:31-32)
- C. This message over time was completely written down. (Eph 3:3-5; Jude 3)
 - 1. We are to give attention to reading and understanding this message.

(Eph 5:17; 1 Tim 4:13)

B. We are the readers of this work and not inspired ourselves!

- 1. This is God's plan for every man to submit to this perfect word that was delivered. **(Gal 1:6-10)**
- 2. We now must use this word to "test the spirits" if it is from God. We must appeal to the words of inspired men! (1 Jn 4:1, 6)
- 3. When teachers claim the Holy Spirit gives a message apart from the written word, then they are preparing one to go beyond what is written. (1 Cor 4:6)
- 4. When a false teacher can break ones strict following of God's word, then they can lead them anywhere! Consider how many come to be Mormons.
- C. The Holy Spirit continues a work today in helping us to pray. (Rom 8:26-27)
 - 1. Here He takes what we are trying to say and deliverers it to the Father on our behalf!
 - 2. What if we do not pray or have wrong motives? (Jas 4:2-3)
- D. Is the Holy Spirit working in our lives?
 - 1. It is very possible for us to fight and stop His great work. (1 Thess 5:19; Rom 8:13-14)
 - 2. Take this test to see if He is working in your life! (Gal 5:22-23)

IV. Things the Holy Spirit does not do

- A. Bow to meet our selfish requests and interests. (Jas 4:2-3)
 - 1. Some view their flesh as the Holy Spirit. Whatever they want must be what God must give them!
 - 2. Others think that whatever they feel in the flesh must be The Holy Spirit speaking to them. "I can feel the spirit present in this place!"
- B. Continue with the signs used to confirm the word in the 1st century. (Mk 16:17-20)
 - 1. These signs were for a purpose and would come to an end. (1 Cor 13:8-10)
 - 2. When the New Testament was delivered then these special gifts ceased! (Jas 1:25)
 - 3. We now are in the time where men who claim these things are not from God! (Zech 13:1-3)

Conclusion: Let us be strong in God's might using the mighty work of the Holy Spirit. (Eph 6:13, 17)

A. Are you being tested in your heart by His word? (Heb 4:12-13)

B. By the Holy Spirit we can see clearly how to serve God and be right with Him!
